Colonel Richard J. Greenwood is the Chief of Staff, Southeast Region, Civil Air Patrol. As such he is responsible for supervising, mentoring, and guiding the Region Staff. Additionally, he serves as a member of the Region Command Team, advising the Region Commander on matters affecting the Region and Staff.
